Purpose of position

 Reporting to the SWN Co-chairs and supported by the SWN program director, the communications subcommittee lead is responsible for managing SWN communication related platforms, sub-committee members and strategic planning

Responsibilities and duties

- Set and achieve annual goals for communications sub-committee in collaboration with the Advisory i.e. monthly social media metrics
- Assign duties to sub-committee members (writing, social media, photography, etc.)
- Develop communications strategies to fulfill strategic priorities
- Create and maintain annual communications calendar for SWN
- Review communication metrics to ensure goals are being met
- Convene and lead sub-committee meetings as needed
- Attend and participate in annual strategic planning session (October/November) and six-month annual plan progress review (May/June)
- As sub-committee lead, you are also a member of the advisory and would attend all advisory meetings acting as the representative of your committee
- Manage performance of members as required

Qualifications

- Passion for excellence in children's health
- 3-5 years experience in Marketing & Communications
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills
- Ability to work with a wide variety of personalities and situations
- Excellent interpersonal skills; open, approachable, tactful, and politically sensitive

- Participate in Advisory annual planning session (October/November), and monthly Advisory meetings
- Attend SWN bi-annual meetings (March, overview of the year and key message training and October, six-month check-in on annual plan progress)
- Engage in and promote SWN social media platforms
- Attend and promote SWN events including Stollery Spotlight
- Lead and attend sub-committee meetings as scheduled (in person or on the phone)
- Engage in and promote SWN social media platforms
- Term commitment: two years with possible one year extension*Terms are subject to revision in the event that deliverables and/or commitments are not met
